Closing Remarks



Gregory Ara Dumanian, MD, is the Orion H. and Lucille W. Stuteville Professor of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery, as well as chief of the Division of Plastic Surgery at Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine. Dr. Dumanian is a fourth generation surgeon. His great-great uncle Setrak Keklikian was a surgeon in the Ottoman cavalry. His great uncle Hampartsoum Kelikian, an Armenian immigrant, was a surgeon at Northwestern in the Department of Orthopaedics for decades, where he was an innovator and leader in his field. He brought Dr. Ara Vahan Dumanian

from Lebanon as his resident in surgery at Northwestern in 1955, along with numerous other young Armenian physicians. Dr. Ara Dumanian was the second cardiac surgeon in Chicagoland, operating on over 20,000 patients during the course of his career.

Dr. Gregory A. Dumanian grew up in Northwest Indiana. He graduated *summa cum laude* from Harvard and was a member of the Alpha Omega Alpha Honor Medical Society at the University of Chicago medical school. After training for nine years and due to his Chicago roots, Dr. Gregory Dumanian accepted Dr. Thomas Mustoe's offer to begin his practice at Northwestern in 1996 as a plastic surgeon and hand surgeon.

Dr. Dumanian is most proud of his family. He is married to Randa Nahra Dumanian, a Massachusetts Institute of Technology rocket scientist and linguist, and has two children, Zari Prapione and Adom Ribal Dumanian, who attend the University of Chicago and Northwestern University, respectively. Continuing the tradition, Zari has worked in the operating room with Dr. Dumanian on various scientific projects.

The **Orion H. and Lucille W. Stuteville Professorship in Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery** was created by Lucille W. Stuteville in memory of her husband, Dr. Orion H. Stuteville. A graduate of the Northwestern University Dental School and Medical School, Dr. Stuteville was awarded the Alumni Medal in 1984. He was professor emeritus and former chair of the Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at the Dental School. Dr. Stuteville also served as director of the residency program in plastic surgery at Northwestern University.
